- 2. Community Partnerships (Kate & Kristine)

Community Partners 2015-2016 Grant Proposal completed: Education Tools, Signage for events (A Frame & Poster Printing) at a cost of \$700, NTC.

Last monthly Business Mixer was held on October 10th were 16 people attended; 4 new guests, 2 new Platinum members, and 1 renewal pending.

The next Community Business mixer is October 15th from 6:30 PM – 7:30 PM as a Spooky Theme located at Shay Realtor Community Hub. The committee has started the CP Newsletter.

- 4. Elections & Appointments (Randy Arnold)

Dave DeVries has applied for a position on the town council. The applicant's address and PUSD school district have been verified.

5. Executive (Melinda Vásquez)

Committee approved the following changes; enlarging the EC committee to include the chair of each committee and include attendance as part of their regular duties; adjusting the Community Partners support levels to be consistent/without ranges; work with non-profits in the 92129 zip code; create a city grants procedure; create or update transition memos; require all current and prospective members to be a Community Partner at any level; and require prospective members to serve on any committee before being appointed to the TC. EC members reviewed the first draft of the RPTC Conflict of Interest Policy, Conflict of Interest Annual Statement, Record Retention Policy, and Whistleblower Policy.

Chair met with two young High School students regarding their participation on the committee for the upcoming term; Noelle and Jack. Discussed how they will engage people to attend the March Candidate Forum.

Committee held a meeting with Leann on 9/8 with Leeann and Joe of USA Endurance Events regarding the San Diego Holiday Half Marathon (12/27/15). We discussed how the TC is able to assist in providing volunteers for the event, sharing the event with the community, and perhaps having local PQ teams & sponsors involved with the race. Leeann is most concerned with securing permission for race participants to park in the Carmel Mountain Ranch area shopping centers perhaps the TC can assist by reaching out to Mark Kersey's office for help and also contacting the shopping center property management on their behalf to request permission. We agreed to talk again in a few weeks with USA Endurance Events.

11. Web & Print (Darshana Patel) - No report

W&P appointed Elijah Nicolas as webmaster and promptly provided him with all accounts, usernames and passwords. W&P Committee met with Geoff Fox and he will diagnose the current status of the RPTC and provide an estimate of how much time it would take to implement 5 additional features; a website which 1) is responsive (works on computer and mobile devices), 2) has a business directory, 3) has a visual community calendar, 4) has a functional distribution list for newsletter/updates and 5) has a Community signage calendar for scheduling. The committee generated two website posts, and 5 Facebook posts with 444 hits for one post. The next meeting is 9/30/2015.
